\*PPR: related courses that lead to a specific post-high school career or educational outcome chosen by the student and based on the student's interests and High School and Beyond Plan and are intended to provide a focus for the student's learning, which may include Career and Technical Education, one of the required Art credits and/or two credits in the same World Language.

\*Two consecutive years of the same World Language are needed for entrance into a 4yr University/College and will meet the PPR requirement.
